## **Description**

ITB 573 is a very early, fast maturing F1 hybrid with potential for a typically aromatic burley style of tobacco, good productivity, PVY<sup>N</sup>, black root-rot and TMV resistance.

ITB 573 produces 21 harvestable leaves, with plants typically 1.5 m tall after topping, and erect to semi-erect leaves. Flowers open slightly later than ITB 501 and earlier than TN 90LC. In south-west of France, topping would typically occur 68 to 72 days after transplantation.

ITB 573 has ability to ripen in an even way from bottom to top. In average conditions it may be stalk cut 2 weeks after topping.
