Description		
<p>ITB 1000 is a dark air-cured variety with potential to produce a high quality classical dark "Paraguay" style tobacco, very good hardiness in European climates, blue-mould tolerance, PVY^N and TMV resistances.</p> <p>In France, ITB 1000 produces an average sized plant, close to the traditional dark "Paraguay" tobacco. The number of harvestable leaves after topping is in average 18. The topping date (first flowers opened) is in average 53 days after transplantation. ITB 1000 is suitable for stalk-harvest or leaf harvest. In France, stalk harvest would typically happen about 90 days after transplantation.</p> <p>ITB 1000 shows a good air-curing ability. In trials, cured leaf productivity is from 3200 to 4300 kg/ha, depending on years and conditions. ITB 1000 produces a high quality air-cured tobacco, with an evenly spread dark brown colour.</p>
