<u>Description</u>		
<p>ITB 33024 is a filler flue-cured variety with medium to early leaf maturity, PVY^N and black root-rot resistances.</p> <p>In south-west of France, ITB 33024 produces a vigorous plant, typically 1.3 to 1.4 m after topping, with in average 20 usable leaves. Its topping date is close to K326, about 73 days after transplantation.</p> <p>Harvest may be complete by mid September in France, 2 - 3 weeks before K326. ITB 33024 shows good curing ability and a high productivity. ITB 33024 typically produces a filler flue-cured tobacco, with a homogeneous light lemon colour.</p>
